Return to Play Framework

Information provided may change as guidelines and mandates are updated by OWHA and PHU anytime.

We will update changes as they occur.

All sanctioned events will:

- Participants fill out either paper or online Medical Screening information prior to any Association event
- Follow all OWHA, PHU and Facility guidelines and mandates
- Contact tracing if there is a positive COVID-19 and follow procedures outlines by the Association
- Promote good hygiene practices by washing hands or sanitizing them before and after sanctioned events
- All participants must be registered on OWHA
- Certified Coaches and Trainers on Benches
- **Players can only play for one (1) Association and under (1) Governing Body. Basically if you register under PCGHA/ OWHA can't play for OMHA, Alliance etc..**
- Dressing rooms being open may be very limited. In some cases players may need to come partially dressed until Facility guidelines change.

- Draft for more than one team in a division
- Only acceptable request is siblings, we are not accepting any others

We will notify all registered members of any changes or updates ASAP

U9-U22

- Program will begin mid-September to March 2021
- September - Thanksgiving to be development/practices
- Maximum of 30 on-ice participants including coaches and volunteers for practices. Depends on facility guidelines and may increase.
- Non-Contact Drills
- Approx. 2 ice times per week
- Flexible non-traditional hockey programs for the 2020-21 season until further guidance comes forward from OWHA
- Teams may consist of 9 players and 1 goalie. Number of players per team can be reviewed but will need to fit within 50 participants per group by PHU (Public Health Unit) Coaches and trainers are also included in that number a
- Upon approval of PHU, OWHA teams may be in pods of 4 - 5 teams from the Niagara Region Loop /GHGHL and as of mid -October (Thanksgiving) 4on4 gameplay. Number of teams may vary due to registration numbers.
- Modified 4on4 games OWHA will provide adjustments to rules for play limiting contact play as much as possible.
- OWHA will notify us if we can play 5on5 possibly in the future.
- Playing against other Associations in the Niagara Region (St. Catharines and Niagara Falls) or in-house play if possible. Subject to agreement between Associations.
- On-ice sessions must comply with public health authority and facility requirements meaning physical distance instruction for

practices on the ice, stay on your own side of the rink, physical distancing on the benches and locker rooms if available.

U9 Cross-ice (half-ice) games begin will vary under Hockey Canada

- Approx. 2 ice times per week
- Non-Contact Drills/Development - Hockey Canada Guidelines
- Any gameplay to begin January
- Maybe inhouse only if registration numbers are available, this will determine the number games in the season.
- Will be reviewed

Sr. House League

- Program will begin mid-September to March 2021
- Practices September - pick teams
- Teams maybe 9 skaters and a goalie - each team needs a player rep and certified trainer. Must fit in the 50 participant guidelines
- Modified games (4on4) to start October, rules to be provided by OWHA
- Maybe in-house if enough players or play in a small Niagara Region Loop with St. Catharines in a 50 participant group
- Approx. 1 ice time per week
- Must comply with public health authority and facility requirements

Jr/Sr Fundamentals mix U7-U14

- The program will begin mid-September
- On-ice instruction from September to March
- Non-Contact Drills
- Maximum of 30 on-ice participants including coaches and volunteers.
- Ice surface will be divided into 3 groups of 10 or 2 groups of 15
- On-ice sessions under public health and facility requirements.
- 1 per week (weekend)
