PAYSA Soccer Scholarship

Scholarship Application Rules & Regulations

THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO PRINCE ALBERT HIGH SCHOOLS WITH SOCCER PROGRAMS ONLY.

1. Scholarships shall be awarded to **one male and one female student athlete** proceeding from Grade 12 to any **Canadian** University or other Secondary Institution approved by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
2. Candidates must complete the application in full and provide all required information, documents, and letters in order for their application to be considered.
3. Scholarships will be paid by PAYSA to successful applicants upon receipt of a fulltime course of studies confirmation at an accredited **Canadian University or College**. Recipients of this scholarship will have to commence their fulltime course of post-secondary studies by September of the following year to claim their scholarship funds.
4. A candidate must have the proficiency in soccer and be currently **registered with PAYSA** as indicated by his/her play and have shown worthwhile contributions to the sport.
5. A candidate must have demonstrated good citizenship, character, and leadership.
6. The following must accompany the application (all documents must be provided):
 - a) A letter from the principal, administrator or coach certifying the candidate's age, character, ability, participation in school activities as well as endorsing this scholarship;
 - b) A transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Record Card. If neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the principal's or secondary administrator's signature will be accepted;
 - c) A letter from a coach or teacher indicating the candidate's character, leadership examples, participation in community activities, as well as information regarding the candidate's soccer ability or contribution to the school and/or community;
 - d) A letter from the applicant indicating qualities, achievements, and participation **both in the school and in the community**.
7. It is the responsibility of the candidate to see that the application is complete and that all required information, documentation and letters are enclosed with the application.
8. The school will be responsible for selecting and recommending their award candidates.
9. The Scholarship Selection Committee will not enter into correspondence with any scholarship applicant or his or her agent. The decision of the Committee is final.
10. There will be one award of \$250 to each male and female candidate to the maximum \$500 available to each high school.

- ✓ ↑ Attached a transcript of marks or a photocopy of your permanent record
- ✓ ↑ Included 1 x Head & Shoulder Colour Photo (Size 2"x1.5) of the Applicant
 - Print your name and school on the back of the photo

↑ Submit 3 x copies of the entire completed application form, including all letters, but only 1 photo.

FXED APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Scholarships are conditional, in that the funds will be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof that he/she is attending a post-secondary institute approved by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
