#### PRO HOCKEY EUROPEAN TRIP CHECKLIST



- Trip Cancellation & Supplemental Insurance (Covid) Mandatory.
- ★Pack uniforms + 3 pucks, 3 sticks, skate blades, tape and laces.
- Pack your semi-formal clothing for opening ceremony banquet.
- \*Carry a <u>Canadian</u> or <u>American</u> Passport that is valid well beyond the date of your anticipated return home; keep a copy of the identification page separate from the original.
- Leave copies of your passport identification page, itinerary, and <a href="insurance policy">insurance policy</a> with friends or family.
- If <u>travelling with children</u>, carry documentation proving your right to accompany them (e.g., a consent letter or court order).
- \*Anticipate financial needs, such as local currency and departure tax.
- <u>★ Take care of health needs</u>: vaccinations, prescriptions, medical certificates, supplies, extra eyeglasses.
- \*Carry an <a href="Emergency Contact Card"><u>Emergency Contact Card</u></a> with the coordinates of the nearest Canadian government office in your destination country.
- ★Arrive 3+ hours before departure.
- Let Credit card companies know you will be travelling.

#### Window Shop in the Quadrilatero d'Oro

Watch the beautiful people parade up and down the streets of the Quadrilatero d'Oro. Stroll down the sidewalk and check out Prada, Armani, Versace, Dolce & Gabbana, Ferragamo, and Valentino.



#### **Visit The Milan Cathedral (Duomo)**

If you only have time to see one sight in Milan, this would be it. Milan's Duomo is, after all, the world's fourth largest, taking half a millennium to build. Begun in 1368, the breathtaking Gothic cathedral can hold 40,000 people

**Eat at "Luini Land".** Beside the Duomo, visit Luini and try the legendary panzerotti — a fried pastry triangle stuffed with tomato and oozing mozzarella — originally from Puglia, but definitely one of Milan's most recognizable treats.





#### **Become inspired by The Last Supper**

Leonardo da Vinci's The Last Supper is undoubtedly Milan's best-known attraction; Examine the expressions of consternation, hostility and despair on the faces of the disciples, just as Jesus reveals his imminent betrayal.

**Scale Mont Blanc**. Well, sort of... The view from of the 3,842 metre Teleferique l'Aiguille Du Midi cablecar, is breathtaking.
