Assessment Guidelines

- 1. Players must be registered with the PRBA prior to participating in assessments.
- 2. Players must have the registration fee paid, or payment arrangements made, prior to participating in assessments.
- 3. Players can expect to have a number written on their leg or arm to aid the assessors. A non-permanent/washable marker will be used.
- 4. Assessments are limited to players and assessors. They are not open to spectators.
- 5. Assessors will be assigned to ensure fairness in the assessment process.
- 6. Assessment sheets for each age group will be provided to the assessors by the PRBA for the first assessment. This sheet will contain the name of each player and previous years' team/age group (if applicable). Assessors should number the players and write the number on the assessment sheet that corresponds to the player's name.
- 7. Parent coaches WILL NOT assess their children for placement.
- 8. Equal assessment opportunity will be given to each player. This includes participation in drills, scrimmage time etc.
- 9. Coaches for any given age group will be permitted to lead the assessment activities but will not complete an official assessment of the players.
- 10. Assessment sheets will be finalized and submitted to PRBA. The PRBA will discuss assessment results with coaches identified for the age group before rosters are finalized.
- 11. Coaches will be assigned to teams when rosters are finalized. This ensures fairness in the assessment process for all players and removes perceived or unintended biases in the assessment process.
- 12. A player may choose not to participate in the assessment process with the understanding that this will result in them being assigned to the team playing in a lower Division.
