Quad Town Minor Ball Association 24-hr Policy Effective: April 15, 2023

Quad Town Minor Ball Association (QTMBA) is adopting the 24 hour policy in an effort to address significant concerns, while attempting to remove the emotional concerns, particularly in the presence of the youth athlete.



This means that parents/guardians are not permitted to confront a coach, team, league official, or association to discuss any "negative" game or practice situation with the coaching and management staff until at least 24 hours have passed from the completion of the game or practice.

A confrontation shall consist of any conversation, which is elevated from a normal speaking tone and demeanor to one which involves yelling, profanity or derogatory comments toward said coach, team or league official. After 24 hours have elapsed, the parent/guardian may address their concern with the coach, team, league official, or association.

By respecting the 24-hour policy, concerns are MORE likely to be fully addressed in a reasonable discussion. More importantly, the kids' enjoyment of a game won't be marred by an ill-timed confrontation. The intent of this rule is to move an emotional and confrontational discussion away from the presence of the players, allows the parties time to compose themselves, and put the incident or situation that occurred in the game in perspective before meeting to discuss it.
