Job Description: We are looking for a dynamic and motivated Youth Soccer Coach to lead soccer practices and attend games for youth teams ranging from ages 4 to 13. The ideal candidate will have experience working with children, a strong understanding of soccer fundamentals, and a passion for creating a fun and supportive environment. You will be responsible for planning and running practices, coaching during games, and helping young athletes develop their skills, confidence, and teamwork.

Responsibilities:
