



Red Deer Lacrosse Association Volunteer Commitment

The RDLA Executive has identified many types of job functions, which occur both in-season or throughout the entire year. To ensure successful operations, it is imperative that the membership base volunteer to perform these tasks or that additional help be hired to complete the tasks. It is expected that ALL volunteering obligations will be met by the registrants family member(s).

RDLA requires a \$100.00 deposit to be paid (per family) upon registration.

Each RDLA family is required to volunteer a **minimum of 10 hours per player** (15 hours minimum per family with more than one registrant). It is expected that families will make every effort to disperse their hours among all their children's teams.

There will be **4 volunteer hours** required for each player during **Tradition Lives Tournament**. These hours will be mandatory and are allocated from EACH players' team, regardless of number of players in your family.

If the family is unable to complete a task, then the registrant must make alternate arrangements and inform the volunteer coordinator.

If a family does NOT complete their volunteer commitment, their volunteer refund will be forfeited. There is no allowance for partial volunteering 100% volunteering effort or 100% payment (\$100.00) is expected.

Please keep track of your hours. It is up to each family to be aware whether they have completed their volunteer commitment.

A **volunteer reimbursement form** must be submitted for each player to their teams volunteer coordinator by JUNE 10. It is up to you to track and fill out the form with your volunteer hours/duties. The team manager will sign off on all forms where obligations have been fulfilled.

The Treasurer and Volunteer Coordinators will meet in Mid- June and make every effort to have refunds available for the close of the season. Mail outs will follow if necessary.
