

## Friends on Ice Co-Director Description

The U12 division are the owners of the Friends on ice and as such, the senior director is a U12 parent. It is strongly recommended that the junior director be a U10 parent moving up to U12 next season. This allows them to learn the ropes, become the primary in their second season and roll out as their child moves up to U14.

The role is to mentor under the primary Friends on Ice Director to learn the processes and activities required to execute a successful tournament.

The role is a 2 year position, first year as a mentor and second year as the primary Director

Activities start in the spring prior to the tournament. Many agreements have been set in place that allow season to season transition.

Kick off meetings start in the fall is shortly after teams are organized, each team is to provide representatives to take on a function within the tournament.

Ice contracts are submitted by the Association ice allocator.

Game schedule may be delegated to other individuals if required.

Referee application process is set in cooperation with the Referee In Chief

Referee scheduling may be delegated to other individuals but is still closely tied to the RIC.
