- Coaches and Managers must complete the 'Respect in Sport' program. This is an RLSA & Softball Saskatchewan requirement. It is a three hour on-line course. Information can be found on the Softball Saskatchewan website, [softball.sk.ca](http://softball.sk.ca), under Respect in Sport.
- Team applications are voted on at the Spring League meeting (generally held in late March). Each team is required to maintain a performance bond to cover the cost of penalties that may be assessed to the team. The current amount is \$500. The bond, application, and roster must be submitted prior to the Spring meeting. Performance bonds can be paid by cash or cheque payable to Regina Ladies Softball Association or e-transfer to [admin@reginaladiessoftball.ca](mailto:admin@reginaladiessoftball.ca).
- Each team is required to provide a representative to a Spring and a Fall League meeting. Failure to do so results in a \$50 penalty applied to the performance bond.
