

RMHA COVID SAFETY PLAN – EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 22, 2021

Referring to the Provincial Health Order, "Gathering and Events", September 18, 2021, the requirement for proof of vaccination is now in place for game-days. Revelstoke Minor Hockey Association (RMHA) works with the City of Revelstoke to design our guidelines for arena use. We are continually monitoring the latest BC public health orders and, as such, all guidelines below are subject to change. Our arena usage guidelines are as follows:

Practice and Inter-community play

- Proof of vaccination <u>NOT</u> required (for youth sport under 21 years of age).
- Spectator group size is limited to a maximum 50.
- Spectators are parents and family watching from the stands; this does not include volunteers, players, coaches, bench staff.
- Masks are mandatory for individuals 12 years of age and older except field of play which is defined as the bench and ice.
- Recommend 2m of social distancing.
- No spitting anywhere in arena.
- No entry to anyone showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, soar throat).
- All water bottles to be clearly labelled.

Games and Tournaments

- <u>Proof of vaccination **IS** required by all those entrants over 12 years of age on game day. After October 23rd, 2021, proof of double vaccine will be required.</u>
- Players and coaches are exempt from vaccine requirements.
- Spectator group size is limited to a maximum of 50; <u>one spectator per player</u>. This number excludes the field of play members (players, coaches, referees, timekeepers).
- Contact tracing will be recorded by the COVID ambassador of the RMHA for everyone that enters the arena on gamedays.
- Players and coaches will be permitted to enter the arena 30 minutes before the start of the game.
- Masks are mandatory for individuals 12 years of age and older except field of play which is defined as the bench and ice.
- Recommend 2m of social distancing.
- No spitting anywhere in arena.
- No entry to anyone showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, soar throat).
- All water bottles to be clearly labelled.
