



RHRA – Team Jersey Policy

RHRA has adopted a new jersey policy that is being implemented this season. All players and goalies on the U14 teams are required to purchase a new set of home and away jerseys (\$150 for the pair) that is theirs for the season and future seasons with RHRA. Payment is made to payments@rhringette.com (indicate player name and team). Team managers will assist to collect jersey size and number for their team and submit it to the RHRA jersey manager. Jersey number allotment will be predefined by RHRA to avoid / minimize duplication in future years.

Current U16 and U19 teams are also highly encouraged to purchase a new set of home and away jerseys as well. Players who purchase their existing jersey will be prorated (\$120 for the pair). Players who decide to purchase jerseys will have priority for jersey number.

Alternatively, U16/U19 players may continue with our current process with the following modifications:

- A \$150 jersey fee deposit is collected by the team manager at the beginning of the season (this fee is returned to players at the end of the season when both jerseys are returned to the team manager). Players may decide to keep their jerseys and would then not receive their deposit back. Unreturned deposits for these jerseys are forwarded to RHRA by team managers.
- If a player needs a new size / number (due to duplicate numbers on the team); jerseys from the existing inventory will be used first before any new purchases are made. Requests for specific numbers may be made but will be limited to what is available in the existing inventory for that size. Senior players (by birth year) will have priority of jersey number.

U12 and FUN 1, 2, 3 teams are not required to purchase jerseys. A deposit fee will be collected by the team manager at the beginning of the season and returned to players upon the return of both jerseys. Name bars are not placed on U12 and FUN teams.
