Provided by the Richmond Ringette Association, this scholarship is open to ringette players, coaches, on-ice officials, volunteers, and executive/board members (details of eligibility included in application).

Dennis Minns started coaching ringette in 1982 and had a drive and passion for the sport that was inspiring to his players and fellow coaches. Dennis was loved and respected by the kids he coached and wanted them to achieve their best and share his love of the sport of ringette. He had many coaching accomplishments including coaching teams at Westerns and Nationals (and winning gold at Westerns one year too!). Dennis was an upbeat and positive coach and role model with a passion for helping others. He is known for saying “Let’s get out there and have fun!” at every game.

Purpose of the Dennis Minns Memorial Scholarship:

To provide an annual scholarship of \$500 towards post-secondary education for ringette players, coaches, executive members, volunteers, and/or officials who demonstrate a commitment to post-secondary education, commitment to the sport of ringette, and who demonstrate a commitment to volunteerism in sport.

In addition to the financial award, recipients will receive a scholarship award certificate and have their name on a perpetual plaque displayed in one of the Richmond area ice arenas.

Eligibility for the Scholarship

1. Participants who are registered, and in good standing, with their home Ringette Association including:
 - Ringette players
 - Ringette coaches who are certified or in the process of becoming certified with Ringette Canada
 - Active on-ice ringette-certified officials (have to be a referee in the year the scholarship is given)
 - Volunteers who volunteer at least 15 hours in the year of the scholarship application (e.g., Board Members, parent helpers, assistant coaches, managers)
2. Documented completion of grade 12 diploma or transcript from term 1 report card if applicant is in grade 12 at the time of application.
3. Demonstrated a commitment to helping in sport (not limited to ringette). Applicant must provide documentation of at least 15 hours of volunteer work in sport for the ringette season (September 2021-date of application).
4. Applicants who have graduated from grade 12 must provide proof of registration in a first year post-secondary education program in a recognized postsecondary training program, college, or

university (part-time or full-time).

- 5. Demonstrated ongoing commitment and dedication to the sport of ringette through playing, coaching, officiating and/or other volunteer activities.

Application Process

Completed applications must be submitted by December 31st 2021 to president@richmondringette.com
Applications will be reviewed by the **RRA Scholarship Committee** and Dennis Minns' daughters.

Notification

The RRA Scholarship Committee will notify the successful applicant during the WCC 2022 tournament Jan 7-9th, 2022. The Scholarship Committee reserve the right to choose not to award the scholarship if the pool of candidates does not meet the criteria outlined or if there are no applicants. For recipients who are in grade 12, they will be presented with their award at their high school award night. For recipients in their first year of college or university, they will be presented with their award at the RRA Annual General Meeting.
