



Arena Guidelines for Volunteers

As a volunteer for the Ridge Meadows Minor Lacrosse, we ask that everyone adheres to the guidelines and requirements put forth by the facilities, PHO and City. Any volunteer in breach of the guidelines may be subject to suspension. We ask that all volunteers show respect for facility staff and their rules. **Masks are not mandatory, but are recommended for anyone not fully vaccinated.**

Planet Ice Arena: Maximum Occupancy 100

Managers must ensure the total occupancy for any event (practice or game) does not exceed the maximum occupancy.

Chrysler Arena Maximum Occupancy 300

Managers must ensure the total occupancy for any event (practice or game) does not exceed the maximum occupancy.

Volunteer Roles and Responsibilities

Coach/Assistant Coach

- Coaching staff will check in with Team Manager at facility and confirm Health Check
- As per BCLA guidelines teams are allowed a maximum of 4 coaches on the bench.

Team Manager:

- The TeamSnap Health check should be updated for all players attending the event.
- Responsible for making sure attendance for the session is accurate.
- Monitor all participants to make sure they are adhering to facility rules.
- Assure spectators do not exceed arena occupancy.
- Assure spectators exit the facility immediately following session, and players/coaches exit within 30 min.

Safety Ambassador

- Check in with the Team Manager.
- Evaluate players experiencing any head injury, following the concussion management guidelines.
- Provide assistance for any other player injuries and have access to appropriate first aid supplies. (gloves, band-aids, sanitizer).
- Safety Ambassadors are to observe from the stands, Safety Ambassadors are only allowed on the bench to attend to a player injury or to conduct a concussion evaluation.
