Return to Play Guidelines

As per the Parent/Player code of conduct signed by all registered members, it is expected that members and their families will follow our Return to Play guidelines. Any breach of these guidelines may result in consequences for the players or members, including participation and status with the Association.

All opposing teams should be made aware of our policies and any breach in conduct may result in a forfeiture of the game. We ask that team managers send the Field Entrance and Exit Plan to all opposing teams prior to games, if a contact name and email is not available please forward to your PCFLL Commissioner.

RMMLA currently allows spectators during games/events. We encourage only one parent per player and require all spectators to adhere to the social distance guidelines put out by the province and allow for 6 feet of distance between others. As per PCFLL and Municipal guidelines we ask that opposing team managers submit a contact tracing roster with names and phone numbers of all players and parents in attendance to the manager of the home team. Managers must keep a list of players/parents in attendance for all games/practices for 30 day. If you are using Team Snap, you can export a list of attendance for each event for your records.


Field Setup/Player Arrival

Coaches/Managers, if you are the first team of the day please arrive no more that 30 mins prior to a game to set up your field. If there is another team or association on the field when you arrive please wait until the field has cleared to enter and set up. Players should not enter the playing field until the previous team has left the playing field. Spectators/Parents are not allowed on the playing field at any time. We ask that coaches wrap up practices in a timely manner so the next team can start their practice on time. For games there should be 30min between each game start to allow for setup and for the field to clear of the previous group.

Players are to arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to games/practices. Players are not permitted to enter any turf or field until their allotted field has been cleared, teams are also only allowed to use the field they have been assigned to for practice/games, please do not warm up on neighboring turf fields even if they are empty. Teams are asked to not gather after practice/games have finished and leave the area within 15 minutes. These are rules set forth by the municipality and MUST be followed or we will lose our access to facilities.

Entrance and Exit Plans

Entrance

Players are to stay in their car until 15 mins prior to the start of their event.

Players are required to dress at their vehicle and arrive at the field in full gear. We encourage all players to leave their gear bags and bins in their vehicle as no bins or bags are allowed on the field of play or near the entrance to the field. Players are to enter at the main entrance to the field

Exit

Players are to exit by the baseball dugout in the far corner. We ask that when leaving, players walk around the outside of the fields and not walk back towards the entrance.

Entrance

Players are to stay in their car until 15 mins prior to the start of their event. Players are required to dress at their vehicle and arrive at the field in full gear. Players can enter the field at the main entrance to the field by the parking lot.

Exit

Players are asked to exit the field at opening close to the players benches. We ask that players follow the path around to the parking lot and not congregate back at the entrance.
