Bylaw Amendment – Special Vote:

Dissolution Bylaw

- 19 The Society may be dissolved only by a special resolution passed by at least 75% of the members present and entitled to vote at a meeting called for that purpose.
- 19.1 The Society must provide notice of such meeting to all members at least 21 days prior to the meeting date, clearly stating the intention to vote on the dissolution of the Society.
- 19.2 After dissolution is approved, the Society must comply with all applicable law and regulations regarding winding-up and dissolution of a society.
- 19.3 In the case of dissolution of the Rimbey Minor Soccer Association by Special Resolution as approved by the members, the remaining assets of the organization after payment of outstanding debts will be paid to a not-for-profit organization that has objects and goals similar to those of the Rimbey Minor Soccer Association.
- 19.4 Members will select the organization to receive the assets by Special Resolution.
- 19.5 The Society shall keep all relevant documents and records regarding its dissolution, including the special resolution and the distribution of assets, accessible for inspection by its member or the Registrar.
