

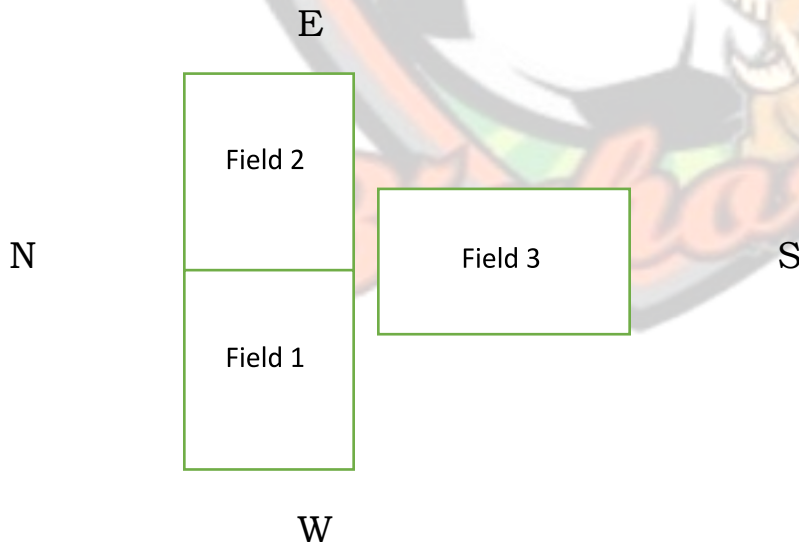
# JUANITA BENDER MEMORIAL U9 SOCCER TOURNAMENT

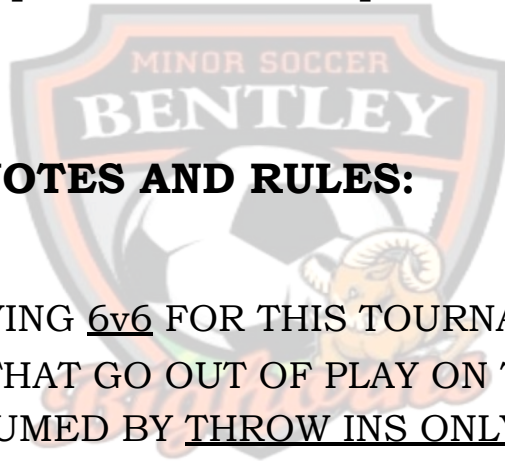

- FOR ANY BALLS THAT GO OUT OF PLAY ON THE SIDELINE, PLAY WILL BE RESUMED BY THROW INS ONLY (THIS IS WHAT OUR MINI REFS ARE TRAINED IN)

- 25 MINUTE HALVES, WITH 5 MINUTE HALFTIME
- RECOMMENDED MAX ROSTER IS 12 PLAYERS
- RETREAT RULE (HALFWAY LINE) IS IN EFFECT
- IN THE SPIRIT OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, NO INDIVIDUAL PLAYER SHOULD SCORE MORE THAN 3 GOALS/GAME, UNLESS

THE GAME IS WITHIN ONE GOAL! COACHES WILL BE ASKED TO MONITOR THIS AS BEST AS POSSIBLE, AS OUR REFS ARE YOUNG AND WILL BE BUSY ENOUGH REFFING THE GAME!

- COACHES OF THE WINNING TEAMS, PLEASE TAKE GAME SHEETS TO RECORD GAME OUTCOMES AT REGISTRATION TABLE, AS WE WILL NEED THEM FOR TOTAL POINTS
- THIS TOURNAMENT IS TO GIVE OUR U9 PLAYERS THE OPPORTUNITY TO PLAY MORE GAMES AND GET A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE GAME. WE WILL NOT TOLERATE ANY HARASSMENT TOWARDS OUR REFS...THEIR DECISION IS FINAL!
- COACHES, BE SURE TO CHECK IN YOUR TEAM AT THE REGISTRATION TABLE TO COLLECT YOUR 'LUNCH TOKENS' AND HEART AND HUSTLE AWARDS
- HEART & HUSTLE AWARD: COACHES CAN CONSULT AND DECIDE IF THEY ARE PICKING FROM OWN TEAM OR OPPOSING TEAMS AND WILL PICK ONE PLAYER WHO THEY FEEL DESERVES THE 'HEART AND HUSTLE AWARD' (PLEASE ENSURE DIFFERENT PLAYERS ARE BEING PICKED)
- CONCESSION ON SITE ALL DAY
- LUNCH PROVIDED FOR ALL PLAYERS AND 2 COACHES
- TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES: 1. TOTAL POINTS FOR (3 POINTS FOR A WIN, 1 POINT FOR A DRAW), 2. EXTRA POINT FOR A SHUTOUT, 3. GOALS FOR/AGAINST POINT DIFFERENTIAL, 4. PENALTY KICKS BEST OUT OF FIVE. IF STILL TIED AFTER 5 KICKERS, GO TO A 6<sup>TH</sup>, 7<sup>TH</sup>...UNTIL A WINNER IS DECLARED.
