REGISTRATION:

ALL officials need to register via RAMP – please follow these instructions at www.ringettealberta.com/referee-registration to register

SCREENING

NEW for 2025/26

Officials 18+ must submit a Vulnerable Sector Check and upload it to their RAMP profile. Ask your association for the letter to bring to Police/RCMP.

SYSTEM CHANGE

Ringette Canada is moving from officiatingringette.ca to RAMP.

- Intro to Officiating (Sept): Old system
- All other clinics (Oct+): RAMP
- Rankings will be updated in RAMP throughout the season.

CLINICS

- Intro to Officiating: Contact local association before enrolling (Starts 09/15).
- Rule Change & PD Clinics: Required for all officials (online, starts Oct). Focus: new rules + communication skills.

FIRST STRIPES

Back again! This pre-program is designed for half-ice play and giving our younger officials a safe and confidence-building officiating start. Associations can register their interest to Ringette Alberta, receive materials and run the half-ice officiating program. Youths aged 12 and up can enroll by looking through a manual and then taking a test to confirm their knowledge on the half-ice rules.

NEW RULEBOOKS AND CRESTS

As part of the Rule Change, each official will need a new Rulebook and be given a new crest. Following enrollment into the Rule Change and Professional Development Clinics, each Referee In Chief will be sent the appropriate number of Rulebooks and crests to pass along to their officials. Officials enrolled in the Introduction to Officiating clinics will receive theirs in person.
