

As a member of Ringette Canada, Ringette Alberta abides by this Ringette Canada Reciprocation Policy

Definitions

1. The following terms have these meanings in this Policy:
 - a) ABSSCM – The Alberta Safe Sport Complaint Mechanism, administered and delivered by Alberta Sport Leadership Association.
 - b) Independent Third Party – An external body contracted by a sport organization that is responsible for the administration of certain complaints, discipline and appeals.
 - c) Participants – All categories of membership defined in Ringette Canada’s Bylaws, as well as all participants employed by, or engaged in activities with, Ringette Canada, PTSOs and Local Associations including, but not limited to, athletes, coaches, convenors, officials, volunteers, managers, administrators, committee members, Directors and Officers, spectators, and parents/guardians of athletes.
 - d) PTSO – Provincial/Territorial Sport Organizations affiliated with Ringette Canada.
 - e) Local Association – An association or league affiliated with a PTSO or with Ringette Canada.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Policy is to ensure national enforcement and recognition of all disciplinary sanctions applied by Ringette Canada, PTSOs, and Local Associations.
3. Ringette Canada recognizes the importance of safe sport for all participants in Ringette throughout the country. Ringette Canada also recognizes the importance of information sharing for the consistent enforcement of discipline decisions and for preventing repeat violations by the same individual.

Application

4. This Policy applies to all Participants, PTSOs, and Local Associations.

Responsibilities

5. Ringette Canada will:
 - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Participants to all PTSOs and to the Local Association(s) with which the Participant was affiliated.
 - b) For discipline decisions provided to Ringette Canada by a PTSO, by a Local Association, or by their respective Independent Third-Party, determine per the Discipline and Complaints Policy whether to initiate further action against the Participant(s) named in the decision.
 - c) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by a PTSO and/or a Local Association, and by their respective Independent Third Party.
6. PTSOs will:
 - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions in the PTSO’s possession involving Participants to Ringette Canada and to the Local Association(s) with which the Participant was affiliated subject to confidentiality restrictions of their Independent Third Party.

- b) For discipline decisions provided to a PTSO by Ringette Canada or by a Local Association, determine per its own policies whether to initiate further action against the Participant(s) named in the decision.
- c) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by Ringette Canada and/or a Local Association.
- d) Update their governing documents to reference the reciprocatation procedures described herein.

7. Local Associations will:

- a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Participants to Ringette Canada and to the PTSO with which the Local Association is affiliated.
- b) For discipline decisions provided to a Local Association by Ringette Canada or by a PTSO, determine per its own policies whether to initiate further action against the Participant(s) named in the decision.
- c) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by Ringette Canada and/or a PTSO and their respective Independent Third Party.
- d) Update their governing documents to reference the reciprocatation procedures described herein.

Appeals

8. Decisions made in accordance with this Policy are not appealable.

This Policy is subject to review at least once every three years.
