Excellence Ringette Program - Coach Application Information Package 2024-25 Season

Ringette NS is seeking enthusiastic, experienced, and self-motivated coaches who have high personal, professional, and ethical standards to act as coaches in the Excellence Ringette Program for the 2024/2025 season.

The Ringette NS Excellence Ringette Program

The Ringette NS Excellence Ringette Program provides athletes and coaches with training and competition that is intended to help athletes and coaches achieve their highest level of personal performance. Excellence Ringette training and competition is offered at the U14, U16, U19 and 18+ divisions, and is supplementary to that received by athletes at their Association. The Excellence Program will prepare athletes and coaches to represent Nova Scotia at the Canadian Ringette Championships (16AA/19AA) and the Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships (14AA/16A/19A/18+).

The Excellence Coaching Experience

Team NS coaching staff for CRCs and ECRCs will be selected from the pool of coaches that are screened into the Excellence Ringette Program. The Excellence Ringette Program will encourage and support the development of high-performance coaches by ensuring that there are training opportunities within Excellence. Once coaches are selected into the Excellence Program, they will be provided roles to ensure that they are able to participate based on their individual goals, availability, and skills.

All Excellence coaches will report to Ringette NS and will be expected to adhere to the Excellence Ringette Program Guidelines. Coaches will receive training, development and leadership support as part of their participation in the Excellence Ringette Program.

Eligibility

To be considered for an Excellence coaching position, coaches must:

at a minimum, be Competition Introduction - Trained in ringette,

- commit to achieve Competition Introduction Certified status in Ringette during 2024-25, and
- be a member in good standing with Ringette NS, their local Association and the CRRL.

Coaches will also be required to complete the following training prior to the start of the 2024-25 season:

- Coaching Association of Canada (CAC) Safe Sport Training
- CAC Making Headway in Sport
- CAC Understanding the Rule of Two
- CAC Emergency Action Plan
- Successful completion of a Criminal Records Check and Vulnerable Sector Check
- Other CAC training, as required.

Application Process

Applications will be accepted until April 30, 2024, with the terms of appointment running from May 2024 to April 2025.
