# **JACKIE LAJEUNESSE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

## **Purpose:**

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage academic excellence and the pursuit of higher education among members of Ringette Ontario. To provide annually 2 (two) scholarships of \$1000.00 each (one thousand dollars) towards post-secondary education for Ringette players, coaches and/or officials who have demonstrated a strong academic performance and a commitment to the sport of Ringette. Recipients will also receive a Scholarship Award certificate recognizing their achievements.

## **Eligibility:**

Application for a Scholarship Award may be made by:

- Registered Ringette Ontario athlete, coach, or on-ice official in the current season.
- Applicants who will be enrolled full-time in a recognized post-secondary institution for the upcoming academic year (September to April).
- Applicants must meet the admission standards of the educational institution specified, which must be a university, college or other educational institution located in Canada providing courses at a post-secondary school level.
- Applicants must provide evidence of their acceptance for full-time enrollment at the institution for the upcoming academic year. Funds will not be released by Ringette Ontario until enrollment at the institution for the upcoming academic year has been confirmed.
- Applicants must have actively participated in Ringette for at least three of the last four years and must be registered in the upcoming playing season.

## Application Package:

The following documents are required to be submitted by the deadline:

1. A written submission documenting the significance of participation in Ringette in the applicant's personal development. No more than 500 words.
2. Letters of reference (bearing a current date) from two (2) individuals in the Ringette community.
3. A detailed Ringette resume covering all aspects of the applicant's Ringette activity (as a player, coach, official, fundraiser, local association volunteer, etc.).
4. Application Package must be sent via email to [membership@ringetteontario.com](mailto:membership@ringetteontario.com) no later than April 15th.

## Selection Process:

Applications received by the Ringette Ontario will be reviewed by the Selection Committee, which will include an RO Director at Large, RO Operations Director and RO Executive Director. The Athlete Representative on the Board of Directors will Chair the Selection Committee.

Decisions made by the Selection Committee will be final.
