Games will be held at three venues in Sault Ste. Marie. Below, you'll find details about each location, including addresses, the number of ice pads, and directions.

Northern Community Centre (Host Venue for the Tournament & Ringette Ontario Headquarters)

Address: 556 Goulais Avenue, Sault Ste. Marie, ON P6C 5A9

Ice Pads: 2

The Northern Community Centre is the host venue for the tournament and serves as Ringette Ontario's headquarters for the duration of the event. This modern facility features a twin-pad arena and an indoor turf area. The two NHL-sized ice surfaces have spectator seating capacities of 750 and 250, respectively. The centre will also have vendors on site and game day photos available. Classrooms are available for team warm-ups (please refer to the information package for booking instructions).

Directions: Located near Second Line West, the Northern Community Centre is easily accessible via Goulais Avenue, just a 10-15 minute drive from hotels and restaurants.

John Rhodes Community Centre

Address: 280 Elizabeth Street, Sault Ste. Marie, ON P6B 6J1

Ice Pads: 2

The John Rhodes Community Centre is a premier facility featuring two ice surfaces: a community rink and an NHL-sized rink. On-site amenities include a canteen, restaurant, and pro shop. The Jayteq Pro Shop offers quality skate sharpening and ringette gear, while Ice Breakers Sports Bar and Grill serves excellent food and provides views of both ice pads.

Directions: Located in the east end of the city, the John Rhodes Community Centre is just south of Wellington Street and north of Queen Street. It's a 10-15 minute drive from most hotels and restaurants in the area.

Rankin Arena

Address: 418 Rankin Avenue, Sault Ste. Marie, ON P6A 6K4

Ice Pads: 1

Owned by the Batchewana First Nation, Rankin Arena features a community-sized rink with seating for up to 500 spectators. Mamabear Lunches, located on-site, offers snacks and drinks in the arena's café.

Directions: Situated just off Trunk Road (17E) on the eastern side of the city, within the Batchewana First Nation, Rankin Arena is approximately a 15+ minute drive from hotels and restaurants. It is easily reached from downtown and the east-end areas via Wellington Street East.
