Notes:	
<b>Female Coach on the Bench</b>	All divisions and levels must have at least one woman coach (18 years old and older) fully qualified for the coaching position they hold on the bench. Open and Masters' Divisions are exempt from this requirement. This must be a coach - trainer and junior helpers do not meet this requirement.
<b>Screening Policy</b>	All coaches and bench staff 18 and older are subject to the Ringette Ontario Screening Policy.
<b>1 - Coach Initiation in Sport</b>	This module is a requirement for all coaches to take before they may register in a CSI or CI clinic. This module is available at <a href="https://thelocker.coach.ca">https://thelocker.coach.ca</a>
<b>2 - Make Ethical Decisions (MED)</b>	Participants must attend a 4 hour training (live online or in person)
	Participants complete the clinic and once complete, the evaluation component will be free and is completed on <a href="https://thelocker.coach.ca">https://thelocker.coach.ca</a>
	Participants who only complete the online evaluation without having attended a clinic will not be recognized as complete.
<b>3 - Competition Introduction (CI)</b>	Coaches registering for a CI clinic MUST complete a pre-clinic workbook in their profile before the system will allow the participant to register
<b>4 - Standard First Aid or equivalent</b>	Valid minimum standard first aid and CPR certification from a recognized First Aid program or active employment in a recognized health care profession in which first aid techniques are commonly applied.
<b>5 - 18+ Open (all levels)</b>	18+AA, A, and University teams are required to have a minimum of 1 non-playing qualified bench staff for all sanctioned games. 18+BB and below teams are required to have a qualified bench staff identified on their TRF and game sheets, but this can be a playing staff or a non-playing bench staff. In the case of a player-staff, this person is ultimately responsible for the conduct of the team.
<b>6 - U12, U14 A/B/C, U16 B/C, U19 B/C</b>	CI or CSI will be accepted as CI was the previous requirement or option (U12)
<b>7 - U16AA, U19AA Competition-Development multi-sport module</b>	Competition Introduction (CI) Certified Coaches at the u16AA, u19AA and NRL level, not yet Competition-Development Certified, are required to complete a minimum of one (1) Competition-Development multi-sport course per season, prior to January 31st, until they are Competition Development Certified.
<b>8 - House League</b>	Team does not play in a sanctioned league or attend tournaments.
