## **COACH REQUIREMENTS**

- **Coach Initiation in Sport Online Module**
- Make Ethical Decisions Clinic
- Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation\*
- Making Head Way eLearning Module
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders or Safe Sport Direct Athlete Training
- Volunteer Screening Requirement
- ➤ It is strongly recommended that Head and Assistant Coaches complete the Community Sport Initiation Clinic available through <u>Ringette Ontario</u>.
- At least one member of the bench staff is required to be Standard First Aid Certified or hold <u>equivalent qualifications.</u>
- ➤ Teams must have one member with Standard First Aid at all on-ice events. All proof of Standard First Aid or equivalencies must be submitted to your Club Coaching Manager.
- \*The Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation can only be accessed once you have completed the Make Ethical Decisions Clinic. To access the online evaluation, you will go to <a href="https://coach.ca/">https://coach.ca/</a> and log into the locker.
- At least one member of the bench staff must be a non-playing female, age eighteen or older and present for all sanctioned events.
- ➤ All bench staff requirements must be completed by **November 30**<sup>th</sup> of the current playing year to be an eligible member of the Bench Staff.
