



RINGETTE ONTARIO

2025 U14-18+A PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFICATION & RANKING

Division & Category

The U14A, U16A, U19A, and 18+A female divisions will be held at the 2025 Ringette Ontario Provincial 'A' Championships. Mixed and male Championships may be held depending upon registration. Championship schedules will be prepared by the Ringette Ontario Operations Director.

The 2025 Ringette Ontario A Championships will be held March 13-16, 2025, hosted by the Sault Ringette Club

Qualification

- Championships will host a maximum of ten (10) teams at U16-18+A divisions. If a division has less than ten teams proceeding to Championships, then the next lowest even number will qualify. (Example: If there are 9 teams at U19A, then the Championship will host 8 teams).
- Given the number of teams projected at U14A, the division may be expanded. Once Intent to Proceed Forms are finalized, this will be confirmed (November 2024)
- **U14-U19A:** Sanctioned events hosted between January 3-February 17, 2025 will be used to rank teams for qualification to and seeding in the Provincial Championships.
 - U14-U19A teams must participate in two (2) assigned sanctioned events within the qualification period to be ranked.
- **18+A:** Sanctioned events hosted between October 25, 2024 and February 17, 2025 will be used to rank teams for qualification to and seeding in the Provincial Championships.
 - 18+A teams must participate in two (2) assigned sanctioned events within the qualification period to be ranked.
- Teams will be given the opportunity to rank their tournament preferences, however match-ups will be the priority when assigning tournaments.
- Match-ups will be done by the Ringette Ontario Operations Director.
- No out-of-province teams will be accepted into the ranking tournaments. Ranking games are games played vs other Ontario teams in the same division/category.
- All teams must complete the Intent to Participate/Proceed Form when it is made available.

Ranking

- The winning percentage of the round robin games played between two Ontario teams at the assigned ranking tournaments will be used to rank teams and determine qualification to the 2025 Provincial Championship. No out-of-province teams will be accepted to the ranking tournaments.
- Bonus points:
 - 1st place finish: 1.0 bonus point will be added to the winning percentage
 - 2nd place finish: 0.5 bonus point will be added to the winning percentage
 - Example: A team's winning percentage in qualifying games is 0.750 =75% - bonus points will be added to that amount (76% if they won a ranking tournament, 75.5% if they were the runner-up in a ranking tournament).
