2025 U14-18+AA PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

QUALIFICATION & RANKING

Division & Category

The U14AA, U16AA, U19AA, and 18+AA female divisions will be held at the 2025 Ringette Ontario Provincial AA Championships. Mixed and male Championships may be held depending upon registration.

Championship schedules will be prepared by the Ringette Ontario Operations Director.

The 2025 Ringette Ontario AA Championships will be held February 27-March 2, 2025, hosted by the West Ottawa Ringette Association.

Qualification

- All U14AA, U16AA, U19AA and 18+AA teams will qualify for the 2025 Ringette Ontario Championships.
- Pre-determined sanctioned events hosted between October 24, 2024, and February 9, 2025, will be used to rank the division teams for qualification to and seeding in the Provincial Championships.
 - The Ringette Ontario Operations Director will assign all teams in each division to two tournaments.
 - Given the number of teams at U14AA and U16AA, the assigned tournaments will be selected first based on matchups, and second using team preferences.
 - For 18+AA and U19AA teams, the Operations Director will assign all eight (8) teams to two ranking tournaments.
 - One ranking tournament will be before December 15, 2024, and one will be between January 3 to February 9, 2025.
- Match-ups will be done by the Ringette Ontario Operations Director. No out-of-province teams will be accepted into the ranking tournaments.
- All teams must complete the Intent to Participate/Proceed Form when it is made available (Fall 2024).

Ranking

- The winning percentage of the round robin games played between two Ontario teams at the assigned ranking tournaments will be used to rank teams and determine qualification to the 2025 Provincial Championship. No out-of-province teams will be accepted to the ranking tournaments.
- Bonus points:
 - 1st place finish: 1.0 bonus point will be added to the winning percentage
 - 2nd place finish: 0.5 bonus point will be added to the winning percentage
 - Example: A team's winning percentage in qualifying games is 0.750 =75% - bonus points will be added to that amount (76% if they won a ranking tournament, 75.5% if they were the runner-up in a ranking tournament).
- Teams may attend more than two (2) tournaments within the ranking period; however, only the assigned ranking tournaments will count towards ranking.

Tournament Assignments

Tournament assignments will be done by the Ringette Ontario Operations Director, in collaboration with the Officiating Development Committee.
