

AAA High Performance Program Callout: Program Coaches 2025-2026

Overview

Ringette Ontario is seeking up to 15 coaches to be a part of the 2025-26 Ringette Ontario AAA High Performance (HP) Program.

The Ringette Ontario AAA Program focuses on high performance development and creation of a competitive program that provides U16 and U19 aged players with exposure to high level development opportunities as well as the best high-performance coaching in Ontario. The AAA HP Program allows Ringette Ontario selected coaches, including the Team Ontario Canada Winter Games bench staff, to identify and develop Ontario's most gifted young ringette players, to encourage and motivate them to play for their province, and to provide them with the opportunities to measure and refine their skills at the top-level competitions.

Eligibility

Coaches must have the following qualifications to be considered:

- Competition Introduction (CI) Certification
- At minimum, one completed multi-sport module required for Competition-Development "in-training" status
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders and/or CAC Safe Sport Training
- Making Head Way in Sport
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening

Program Details

Coaches will begin in June 2025 with a series of virtual professional development opportunities. Ringette Ontario will host an evaluation camp in July for invited athletes and program coaches to attend. An evaluation team, that will include the 2027 Canada Winter Games coaching staff, will be evaluating the athletes to rank all athletes and form the AAA Teams. Coaches will assist with ice time execution, participate in off-ice activities, and may assist with evaluations.

Following selection camp, players selected to the program will be invited to the first development camp. At this camp, coaches will work with a coach mentor and athlete development consultant to teach the skills necessary to compete at the highest level. The focus will be on teaching and evaluating how the athletes listen, process, and perform.

Teams will be formed ahead of the final development camp. At the final development camp, coaches will still work together with the mentor coach(es) and athlete development consultant to ensure that key concepts (technical and tactical) are being executed. There will also be team-specific ice times and activities.

Program Weekends

- Evaluation Weekend Ajax: July 18-20, 2025
- Development Camp Location to be Determined October 2025.
- o Development Camp Kitchener: December 19-21, 2025
- Ontario Winter Games Orillia: February 20-22, 2026
- Virtual development sessions will also be delivered in nutrition, physical preparation, mental performance, etc.

What is provided by Ringette Ontario:

- Opportunity to work with many of the top players within the province
- Professional Development Opportunities
- Apparel to represent the team they will be coaching
- Meals, shared accommodations, and travel expenses throughout the program weekends

Application Process
