Ringette Ontario 2022-2023 RAMP Season and Fee Structure

Welcome to the 2022-2023 Ringette Ontario Season!

The Ringette Ontario season officially opens on July 1st, 2022, in RAMP but we will be allowing clubs to go in and start setting up their season starting as of Monday, June 20th.

Many of our member Clubs are now familiar with the RAMP system as it has been slowly integrated over the past three seasons. This season we will require all Clubs to use the front-end registration links provided by RAMP to register your members, this means you will not be able to import data from another registration system that you may have previously used. This *does not* mean that you are required to switch to a RAMP website platform, as the front-end registration link may be placed on your current website or sent to members via email.

The intent of moving everyone to the RAMP registration system is to create a standardized national database that will continue to increase the alignment across the country. By mandating the use of RAMP as the front-end registration system, we will standardize process and consistency on waivers, codes of conducts, policy recognition and Rowan's Law compliance.

Clubs should note that upon registration for athletes, coaches, volunteers, and executives this season, Ringette Ontario membership fees, which include Ringette Canada fees, well as dues and insurance fee's will automatically be taken from their registration, Clubs should adjust their registration rates to reflect these changes and should not be included in individuals Club Fees. This change in process will greatly reduce the administrative burden to associations and Ringette Ontario by allocating the fees and insurance directly to Ringette Ontario, which will also decrease the amount of errors and duplications of fee charges that currently occur.

FAQ's:

1. Our club pays for our coaches and volunteers, can dues/fees/insurance for coaches/volunteers/board members to still be billed directly to the clubs?

Ringette Ontario will work with RAMP to implement a work around for those clubs who pay for their volunteers, we will look to provide each club a "promo code" for its volunteers that they can use when they register and then invoice the club afterwards. Volunteers would still register through the RAMP portal to capture waiver and policy information.

2. How should our club fee structure reflect these new changes?

The process of registration is now basically in two parts, the participant will register using the front-end RAMP link, they will sign off on all their waivers and pay the RO fees (\$56.50) during that process. They are now a registered member of RO and in the RAMP system the club can then charge them their club season fees (\$700). The total cost for the athlete is \$756.50. Clubs should remove RO fees from their fee structure as the participants will be paying that upfront upon registration.

3. Which club pays for an athlete who is transferring, the home association or the new club?

Athletes will register with their home association through RAMP and pay their RO fees during registration, this way there is no confusion regarding which club needs to be invoiced, it will already be paid for by the participant.
