NOMINATION PROCEDURES:

- 1. All registered members of Ringette Ontario are eligible to nominate someone as long as they are not a family member.
- All Nominations are to be submitted via email, with the name of the award the individual is being nominated for along with a detailed resume, and reference letters (if applicable) to <u>clubdevelopment@ringetteontario.com</u>.
- 3. All nominations are due on May 15th.

All nominations will be reviewed, and awards will be chosen by the Ringette Ontario Hall of Fame & Awards Committee. The Committee will be appointed by Ringette Ontario staff and will have representation from each Region, with the Committee members appointing a Chair. The RO Office will work with the Committee to ensure that sufficient information has been obtained for each nominee.
