#### **Schedule**

#### **Division Formats**

##### U12A – Tier 1 & U12B – Tier 2(12 teams)

Two pools of 6 teams. Round robin played within the pool.

Top 4 overall advance to the semi-finals.

Winners of semi-finals advance to the gold medal game.

Losers of the semi-finals advance to the bronze medal game.

##### U12A – Tier 2 (11 teams)

Unbalanced round robin with 11 teams.

Markham-Stouffville will play an extra game on Thursday. Their 2<sup>nd</sup> game will only count for their opponent.

Top 4 overall advance to the semi-finals.

Winners of semi-finals advance to the gold medal game.

Losers of the semi-finals advance to the bronze medal game.

##### U12B – Tier 1 (10 teams)

10 teams – 2 pools of 5 – play across the pools

Top 4 overall advance to the semi-finals.

Winners of semi-finals advance to the gold medal game.

Losers of the semi-finals advance to the bronze medal game.

### U12C (8 teams)

8 teams – 2 pools of 4 – play across the pools

5<sup>th</sup> round robin game will be based on seeding within your own pool (1A v 4A, 2A v 3A, 1B v 4B, 2B v 3B)

Semi-final/bronze: 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall v 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall

Gold medal game: 1<sup>st</sup> place overall vs the winner of the semi final
