



## 2026-2027 Sanctioned Event Information

### Sanctioned Event Applications:

- Applicants must read and understand the agreement in Tab 1 before completing and emailing back the form (Tab 2)
- Application deadline is June 30, 2026
- Ringette Ontario will invoice Clubs for Sanctioned Event Application Fee (\$25 for FunFest events; 150 for all other sanctioned events) and Sanctioned Event team fees (the RO sanctioned event fee for tournaments is \$10 a team for FUN3 (U10) and up) once your event has taken place.

### Event Sanctioning:

- The sanctioned event list will be posted on the RO website by July 14, 2026
- With multiple events being held on the same weekend and with a limited number teams and officials, not all tournaments will be sanctioned to host every division they apply for.
- The Competition Oversight Committee is using the application to ensure the proper number of divisions are hosted and spread out over the season that if a division is applied for and accepted by RO that the expectation is that the tournament Host ensure that they make all reasonable effort to try to host all divisions that they are given. When completing the application, consider carefully what divisions are applied for. If accepted the Host would be expected to host the division unless registration shows not enough to host the division after reasonable effort on the tournament host to fill the division. If help to fill the division is required please approach RO for assistance.
- Tournaments will receive an email from Ringette Ontario regarding tournament division allocations and details on setting up tournament through RAMP tournament site. Clubs must use the RAMP Tournament Software and Game Sheet App when hosting an RO Sanctioned Event. Information sessions on tournament site set up and use of Game Sheet App software will be hosted if necessary.
- A new Tournament Host Guide and Host Resources will also be provided to approved hosts.

### **Assignment of Teams to Tournaments:**

- Ringette Ontario may assign provincial level teams to tournaments for Provincial ranking purposes. Ranking divisions cannot have teams added to them without Ringette Ontario approval. Ringette Ontario will not assign teams in the FUN1/2/3 (U10), U12A and U12-18+B and C level teams to tournaments. Once tournaments open registration teams in these divisions are welcome to apply.
- Tournament withdrawal dates do not apply to A/AA level teams when they have been assigned to tournaments as per the selections they submit. Upon assignment to tournaments, teams are to complete the registration process for each tournament that they have been assigned to. Once a team has been assigned to a tournament, they cannot be denied acceptance into the tournament, and they cannot withdraw from the tournament without approval by the Ringette Ontario Competitions Oversight Committee and RO Operations Director in the case of extenuating circumstances.
