## **Code of Conduct Acknowledgement for Parents/Guardians**

- 1. Do not force an unwilling player to participate in sports.
- 2. Remember that participants should be involved in organized sports for their enjoyment; not yours.
- 3. Encourage your player to always play by the rules.
- 4. Teach your player that honest effort is important and that if the player has given their best then it is a victory regardless of game outcome.
- 5. Help your player work towards skill development, and fun. Never ridicule your player for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 6. Congratulate your player on honest effort and skill improvement, not just goals.
- 7. Remember that players learn best by example. Applaud good plays by either team.
- 8. Do not publicly question the official's judgement and never their honesty. After all have you offered to do the job?
- 9. Abuse of players, coaches, officials, or volunteers will not be tolerated.
- 10. Actively support all efforts to remove verbal and physical violence from hockey.
- 11. Recognize and value the importance of volunteers. They give their time and resources to provide recreational activities for your player.
- 12. Attendance is required. We understand and encourage players to be involved with other activities and this is a team sport and being late or absent especially without notice is very detrimental to the team and consequences will be applied.
- 13. Have players to the rink at coach specified times before practices and games. If you will be late contact the team staff. Failure to do this will result in consequences.
