Code of Conduct Acknowledgement for Players

- 1. Play for the 'fun of it' not just to please your parents or coach.
- 2. Play by the rules.
- 3. Never argue with the official's decisions. Let your coach or captain ask any necessary questions.
- 4. Control your temper; no tantrums, throwing sticks, smashing sticks, 'mouthing off'.
- 5. Work equally hard for your team and yourself; your team's performance will benefit along with your performance.
- 6. Be a good sport. Show class.
- 7. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Don't interfere, belittle, bully, or take advantage of other players.
- 8. Remember the goals of the game are to; have fun, improve your skills, feel good, and learn how to be a team player.
- 9. Co-operate with your coach, team mates, officials and opponents.
- 10. Use of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol during any sanction CRMHA activity will be result in suspension.
- 11. Attendance is important. Coach will set criteria for attendance prior to games and practices. Consequences will be enacted for not communicating with coach prior to an absence or for excessive continued absences. This is a team sport and commitment is required.
