Highlights of Hockey Alberta Regulation Changes

Registration:

When registering for hockey for the first time, a player may register with the MHA of their choice. While this will typically be at the U7 level it is not strictly decided by age. If the first time a player registers is in U11, they will be able to pick their home association at that time. Once a home association is picked, a player release will be required for any future moves between MHA's.

Permission for Player Movement:

- (A)** A player must obtain permission, in writing from their last registered MHA prior to being transferred, in the registry, to a new MHA. The written permission must be uploaded to the transfer.
- (B)** If the last registered MHA does not provide permission, an application for Player Movement can be submitted to Hockey Alberta through completion of the online form.
