

# Information and Conditions for Registration

Please read the following information entirely before filling out your registration application form. For more information on registration, residency boundaries, visit <u>www.salmonarmminorhockey.com</u>.

**Note**: Players are only allowed to participate on one team per year, with the exception of female players who can register for a female-only team and a male-female team (in accordance with SAMHA's Integrated Hockey Policy). The female player would be required to pay the full registration fees for both teams.

- 1. A <u>separate form</u> is to be used for each player registering. A single payment may be used for multiple registration forms per family as long as each player's name is clearly indicated with the payment.
- Registration is based on team configuration guidelines according to SAMHA policies, and the availability of projected ice slots and coaches. Some teams and divisions may not form this year if basic criteria cannot be achieved by **August 31, 2019**. Players registering after August 31, 2019 will be put on a waiting list and registered on a first come, first served.
- 3. Registration cut-off is **November 30, 2019** and players may not be accepted for the current season after this date.
- 4. Registrations received by 4:00 pm (PST) on June 30, 2019 with payment in full dated no later than June 30, 2019 (see Item 9) will be entered in a draw for a FREE 2019-20 Season's Registration! One player from all qualifying Early Bird Registrations received will be selected before the season starts as the winner of the free registration.
- 5. Players indicating that they want to tryout for a Rep or Development team on the registration form will be contacted with their tryout times. Please note these tryouts are for serious players wishing to be accepted on to a rep team. Other players who simply want extra ice time for pre-season conditioning are not permitted to attend.
- 6. Players selected for rep or development teams will pay an additional "Rep" fee once their team is finalized. Players trying out for a rep team will be placed on either the A or B team (if available) or re-assigned to the Recreational program. Rep players will play at the tier deemed most appropriate by the team coaches and evaluators.
- 7. Players registered in Atom Development and higher Divisions will be required to purchase a practice jersey for use during practices. The type and colour will be decided by the coaching staff at the beginning of the season, and the cost will generally be under \$30.
- 8. Full payment is due with the player registration form. If necessary, payment may be made by a minimum deposit of \$100 (cheques dated no later than June 30, 2019) per player included with their application form, plus a maximum of three post-dated cheques for the balance, with the last payment dated no later than November 30, 2019). No player will be allowed without full payment plan.
- 9. For those seeking financial assistance, please view the helpful information contained in the KidSport web site at <u>www.kidsport.ca</u>, and contact KidSport at 832-0108 for confidential assistance.
- 10.No player will be allowed on the ice until his or her registration has been received and accepted by SAMHA, and at least a deposit and post-dated cheques have been received.
- 11. If the player's final registration payment is not received by November 30, 2019, or if any payment is returned as NSF, that player will be immediately suspended from any further SAMHA sanctioned event until payment is made. There will be a \$30.00 administration charge for all NSF payments.
- 12.Pro-rated refunds are available only up to December 31, 2019, less a \$40.00 administration fee plus any Rep carding and BCHockey/HC fees paid.
- 13.No refunds shall be given to suspended players.
- 14. There will be a \$30.00 charge for NSF payments.
- 15.All registrations fees include a team picture, typically taken in the fall, and will be delivered as soon as possible.
- 16. It will be required that all parents/players to participate in the major fundraising projects of SAMHA.

All registrants wishing to try-out for the Regional MML Midget Team <u>must</u> first register with SAMHA first before trying out. MML permission form is available for local association to sign off. Zone team information...please see BC Hockey website for further information.

HCSP program must be completed online. <u>Please Note</u>: Acceptance of coaches, assistant coaches, mgrs., and safety persons will be subject to SAMHA and Criminal Record checks. Can be done on-line on SAMHA website. Must be done immediately once appointed to team or once every three years.

# **Player/Parent Contract**

## This form is to be completed by player and parent and must be accompanied with registration.
