Please provide this letter to the St. Albert RCMP detachment to receive your criminal record check free of charge.

You must be a resident of St Albert. If you are not a resident of St Albert, or you are aware of an offense on your record, you must go to the Edmonton Police Service for a more detailed criminal record check.
