Terms of Employment:

- 8-week term position (May 10 – July 9, 2021)
- 35 hours per week. Typical schedule will be Monday to Thursday from 1:00-9:00pm and Friday from 9:00am-5:00pm; however, schedule may vary. Schedule includes a 60-minute unpaid lunch break.

Wage:

- \$15.00-\$17.00 per hour depending on education and experience.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- On field and administrative component.
- Responsible for planning, organizing, and delivering an appropriate range of soccer focused activities and programs.
- Deliver on-field sessions following the curriculum and Game Model developed by the Club.
- Utilize coaching resources and software to help plan and manage training sessions and match play.
- Deliver additional training programs offered by the Club (ie. camps, community outreach events, etc).
- Other duties as assigned.

Competencies and Skills Required:

- Must have experience as a coach and/or player.
- Possess an understanding of Canada Soccer's Long-Term Player Development.
- Ability to take direction.

- Strong communication skills and the ability to convey information to players, parents/guardians and Club personnel.
- The ability to communicate in English both orally and written is a requirement.
