Indoor Registration Deadline – December 15

The next reporting deadline for the indoor season will be on December 15. If you have had *any* registrations since November 1 these will be to be reported and all associated fees sent in by the deadline, after which late fees may be applied. Registration Fee – Outdoor 2024

Effective Outdoor 2024, player registration fees will increase by \$2.00/player. The resulting fee structure for soccer and futsal participants starting in Outdoor 2024 and going forward will be:

- Mini Player: \$18.00 per season
- Youth & Adult Player: \$34.00 per season
