Saskatchewan Soccer’s Female Development Network provides funding and networking opportunities for female professionals working in soccer to share their experiences, to seek guidance, and to cultivate knowledge with others. This program is open to females 18 and over who are players, coaches, referees, board members, and organizers within the Grassroots, Competitive, and High-Performance levels of soccer in Saskatchewan.

- A \$200 honorarium available upon the completion of the Program.
- Saskatoon-based coaches will be provided access to the SK EXCEL Program on a weekly or bi-weekly basis. Additional honorarium for players participating in the REX Program.

- Opportunities to connect with female leaders within Canada and grow their own network.
- Tailored tasks designed to support future aspirations.

### Mental Performance Coaches Online Workshop – September 19

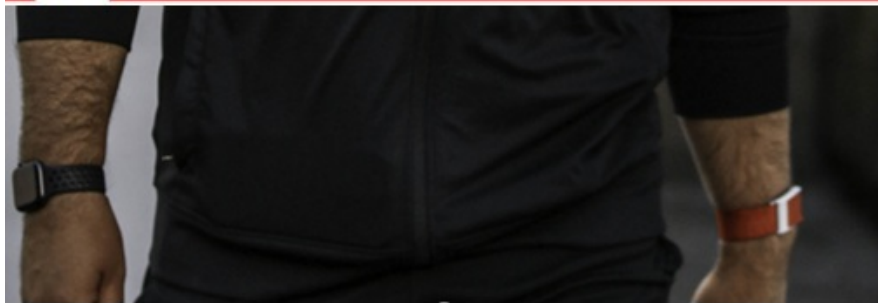
#### About the presentation

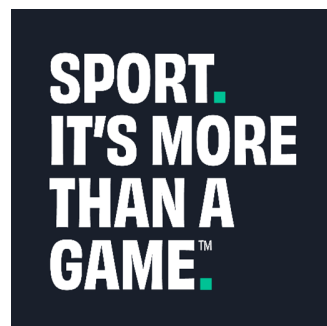
