Saskatchewan Soccer hosted its annual November Member Sessions this past weekend in Saskatoon. The three-day event included education sessions and working meetings providing Member Organizations with an engagement opportunity to discuss the growth of soccer with staff and leading soccer experts.

This year, the sessions kicked off on Friday with technical staff highlighting upcoming technical details related to coach education, reviewing available resources for the coach community, and sharing upcoming updates across the technical landscape.

A Bylaw amendment session kicked off the Saturday plenary, followed by a presentation by Canada Soccer's Chief Operating Officer, Mathiew Chamberland on the future of soccer in Canada. In addition, Sask Soccer partnered with Canadian Women & Sport to bring its Gender Equity Lens workshop presented by Lara Schroder and Tolu Ilelaboye. This engaging session shed light on the importance of gender equity in sports and provided practical strategies to implement gender equity within organizations.

Adam will return to his role with Sask Soccer once the competition finilizes.

Canada will open the FIFA U-17 World Cup Indonesia 2023[™] against Spain on Friday 10 November at Manahan Stadium in Surakarta. Across Group B, Canada will also face Uzbekistan on Monday 13 November at Manahan Stadium and then Mali on Thursday 16

November at Gelora Bung Tomo Stadium in Benowo.
