## HOUSE RULES Saskatchewan Soccer 50/50 DRAW

- 1. The Saskatchewan Soccer Association (SSA) 50/50 is open to the public and subject to Provincial Laws and Regulations.
- 2. You must be at least 16 years old to purchase a ticket.
- 3. The 50/50 Tickets will be sold online using Rafflebox.
- 4. You must purchase a 50/50 ticket to qualify to win.
- 5. The tickets will begin being sold on Tuesday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- 6. The first draw will take place on Tuesday May 25<sup>th</sup> at 2pm at SSA (300-1734 Elphinstone Street).
- 7. There will be a subsequent draw every Tuesday for one year with the final draw completing on May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- 8. Tickets will be sold until 1pm of the day of the draw each week.
- 9. Ticket prices: 1 for \$5, 3 for \$10 or 20 for \$20
- 10. All participants will have their name and phone number recorded online.
- 11. If a draw cannot take place, the draw will take place as soon as possible, with approval from SLGA. This change should only happen due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 12. Winnings will be paid by cheque in the exact name provided on the ticket
- 13. Winnings can be picked up at Saskatchewan Soccer Association photo ID is required or will be sent out via mail.
- 14. Winners will be contacted using the information they provide at the time they purchased the ticket.
- 15. Any unclaimed prizes will be held in a secure location for a period of one year. If unclaimed in that time period, the prize will be donated to a charitable beneficiary as approved by SLGA.





- 16. Total prize value for the weekly draws cannot exceed \$750,000.
- 17. By buying a ticket, you agree to have your name, ticket number and Jackpot Prize published.
- 18. Please keep your receipt In the event of a disagreement in the Draw, precedence will be given to the original receipt issued.
