Even so, alignment continues to be a challenge due to the differing needs among teams. We have learned that while it is impossible to please everyone, we remain committed to decisions that benefit the entire league, rather than any single team or opinion.

To assist, we will continue consulting with teams to address concerns in advance. Although alignment is deeply important to teams and individuals, our role is to approach it objectively. Decisions cannot be made based on feelings. Alignment varies each year depending on the number of teams, roster changes, division requests, and other factors—it is never as simple as it may seem.

Special recognition also goes to the Men's and Women's YXE FC teams who competed in the Masters National Championship in Winnipeg. With the tournament expanding from Westerns to Nationals this year, we couldn't be prouder of how our teams represented us. After a grueling and unprecedented group stage, the YXE FC Men's team won gold in the final against Edmonton Scottish.

We welcomed the new indoor turf for the 2024–2025 season and look forward to the final touches for the completion of the outdoor turf upgrade in spring 2026.
