COMMIT TO KIDS

All your interactions and activities with children:

- should be known to, and approved by SUSC, where applicable, and the parents of the child;**
- tied to your duties as their coach or team manager, and;**
- designed to develop the child's skills in the sport program**

GENDER RULE – EXPLAINED

Canada Soccer requires an adult of the same gender as the players to be present with players. This can be a coach or any member of the team staff. If a team is made up of players who identify as more than one gender, an adult of each gender must accompany the players.

Purpose of Rule of Two

To protect minor athletes and coaches in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring more than one adult is present

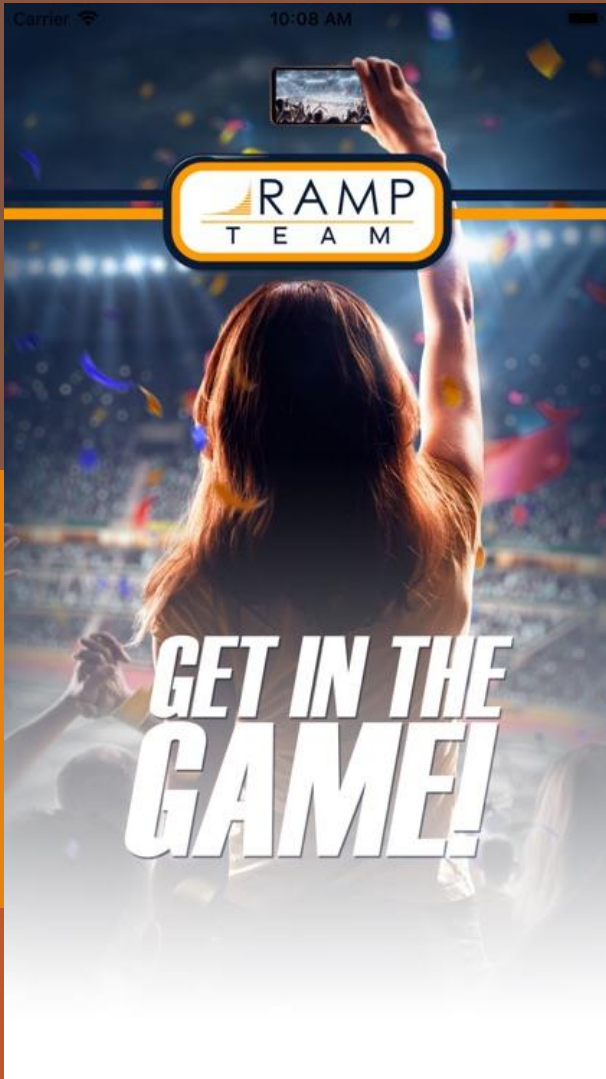

RAMP Team App and Website



FAMILIES CAN CONNECT TO THEIR TEAM TWO WAYS:

1. Download the RAMP Team App on their mobile device. Login using the same credentials as RAMP Registration and the team will load automatically.

OR

2. Visit www.susc.ca and, under the Categories TABs, find their league, age group and team.

ADMINS CAN CONNECT TO THEIR TEAM TWO WAYS:

1. On the Mobile App – Admins have automatic access to admin features.

Late Registrations

- If a player registers late, they may be added to your roster
- The technical team will assess and place the player in the appropriate league
- You will be notified by Jaime of the new player so you can contact the family
- A uniform will be available for them at Soccer Locker

Dreambrokers

- This program operates through select Elementary schools within our zone.
- Provides funding, assistance with registration, and most importantly: TRANSPORTATION, usually taxi cabs.
- Staff are listed as contacts for the players to ensure that their taxi rides are coordinated properly and fees are paid
- Can pay for equipment and team fees if needed

No-show players

- If a player fails to respond to your attempts to contact the family and does not show up to S USC soccer events, please TELL us ASAP.
- S USC will make our best effort to contact the player to investigate why they haven't attended.
- Rosters may be adjusted if players decide not to participate in part or all of the season.
