

Saskatoon United Soccer Club Constitution

The name of the organization is: Saskatoon United Soccer Club.

The objectives of the Saskatoon United Soccer Club are:

- to promote, develop, organize and regulate indoor and outdoor soccer in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan;
- to coordinate the training of players and coaches;
- to educate parents on the game of soccer;
- to facilitate instructional soccer programs at the school, community, club and provincial levels;
- to organize indoor and outdoor tournaments for youth players;
- to facilitate high performance programs for junior players;
- to represent the Saskatoon United Soccer Club within the Saskatchewan Soccer Association and the Canadian Soccer Association and their governing bodies.

The operations of Saskatoon United Soccer Club (SUSC) are to be carried on through the Head Office located within the City of Saskatoon, and shall be affiliated with and under the jurisdiction of the Saskatchewan Soccer Association (SSA) and the Canadian Soccer Association (CSA), and subject to the rules and regulations of these governing bodies.
