Job Title: Parent-Tot Program Leader
Type: Casual Term - 3 hours per week – evenings and/or weekends
Length: Jan 5 – Mar 31, 2020 – possibility of extension
Wage: Hourly \$16.00/hr.

This is an excellent experience for someone interested in obtaining experience in leadership skills, program planning, coaching and sport facilitation. Excellent for students pursuing Recreation, Education and/or Kinesiology or who simply enjoy the sport of soccer and working with young children.

Duties:

- Set up soccer program equipment prior to participant arrival.
- Implement all COVID-19 safety precautions such as wearing a mask, ensuring all parents wear a mask, and all participants use the provided hand sanitizer. Ensure screening questions are covered with all participants prior to starting session.
- Conduct daily attendance and ensure all participants and parents are on the provided list of registered participants.
- Create or follow suggested age appropriate soccer program sessions for a six-week program.
- Engage in and lead fun and exciting soccer activities for children ages 2-4 year with their parent involvement.
- Adapt to the group and make sessions fun and exciting on a weekly basis.
- Evaluate session successes/challenges and determine adaptations or improvements for following week.
- Clean and disinfect all equipment after each session.
- Report timesheets and program attendance on a regular basis.
- Wear provided SYSI program leader shirt to each session and ensure it is freshly laundered prior to each session along with other clothing items.

Skill Sets:

- Ability to work with little to no supervision.
- Personable, outgoing, and energetic; ability to exude enthusiasm and charisma with young children and their parents.
- Perceptive and observant of group enjoyment and needs.
- Ability to adapt, be flexible, and make necessary changes to program delivery for varying skill levels and engagement.

Requirements:

- Must have played some soccer and enjoy the game.
- Experience coaching and/or working with young children ages 2 to 4.
- Valid First Aid and CPR C
- Mandatory Coach Certifications/Training Prior to Start Date:
 1. NCCP Active Start – Free online course
 2. Respect in Sport – Free online course
 3. Making Ethical Decisions– \$35 online course ~ expense reimbursed upon hiring and passing exam with receipt submission
 4. Available for 1-hour orientation and training session with SYSI Program Coordinator prior to start of program
- Criminal record check with vulnerable sector ~ expense reimbursed upon hiring and receipt submission
- License and proper vehicle for transporting soccer equipment to and from field is required.
- Provide availability to program leader so that appropriate session dates/times are created.
- Ability to start by January 2020.
