

Re: COVID-19 Positive Case - Oct 24

Dear Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc. (SYSI) Participants,

A case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed in an individual participating in a mini league within the SYSI League. We are working closely with the Public Health Authority (SHA) to ensure all necessary measures are in place to protect all participants. COVID-19 is transmitted from person to person large droplets, though a sneeze or cough for example.

SYSI has sent a communication to all those in the affected mini league and (SHA) will be contacting parents/caregivers of those who have been in **close contact** with the case and providing direction. To protect the privacy of the individual, we will not release any personal information, and ask that you respect the privacy of others. The risk of exposure to anyone not considered a close contact is low. We remind all those who will be attending soccer functions to monitor for any signs/symptoms of COVID-19 and remind you that all members are obligated to not attend events in any capacity if they have any symptoms, feeling ill, or has been in contact with someone who is ill. Please refer to the **COVID Screening Checklist located in Section 8.0** in the <u>Saskatoon Youth</u> Soccer Return to Soccer Plan.

If you or your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, please call the HeathLine at 811, and remain home. If you require medical attention, please call ahead to your health care provider. If it is an emergency requiring immediate attention please call **911**.
