Games & Practices

Games

- All games for the regular season have been uploaded to the website.
- Season runs from **Oct 22 - Mar 17**. Check your schedule - please contact SYSI if you notice any errors or discrepancies
- Under-5, Under-7 & Under-9 coaches may mutually agree to cancel a game but the game will not be rescheduled.

FIELD START TIMES

Scheduled Start Times

Field allotments are 55 min from the start of the scheduled time. For example, if your start time is 5:15 PM, teams should be gathering their things and leaving the field at 6:10 PM. This allows for any needed field set-up changes between bookings and allows the the next booking to start on time.



U5-U9 FIELD SET-UP

Please be advised all U5, U7 and U9 goals will be set up by the coaches of the first game taking place, and taken down by the coaches of the last game on any given day.

- **Step 1:** Go to the flag storage area that is closest to your scheduled game.
- **Step 2:** A coach from each team will grab 2 flags from your bin
- **Step 3:** A coach from each team will grab 2 bases for the stacks of bases that are neatly stacked on the floor
- **Step 4:** Take your flags and bases to the field of your scheduled game.
- **Step 5:** Once you determine what side your teams' goal will be, place the two flags approximately 10-12 feet apart to use as your goal area for the game.
- **Step 6:** Last games of the day, a coach from each team will collect the 2 bases and 2 flags from their side of the field and take them back to the flag storage area. Please place the flags in the bin neatly and stack the bases on the floor.

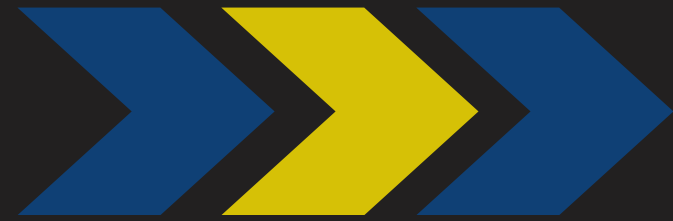

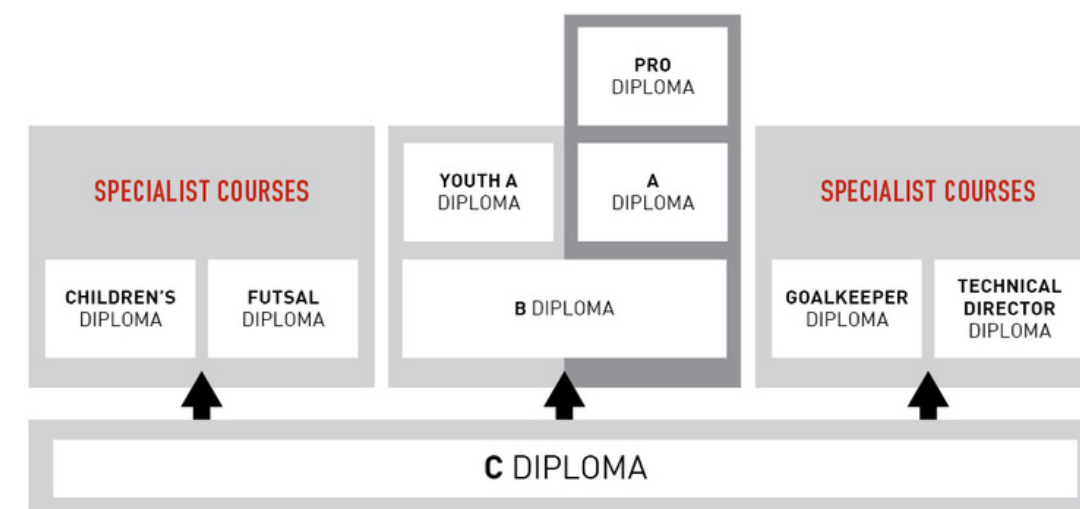

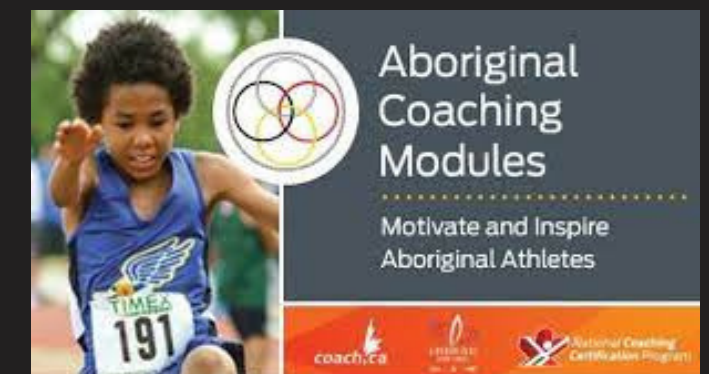

Codes of Conduct

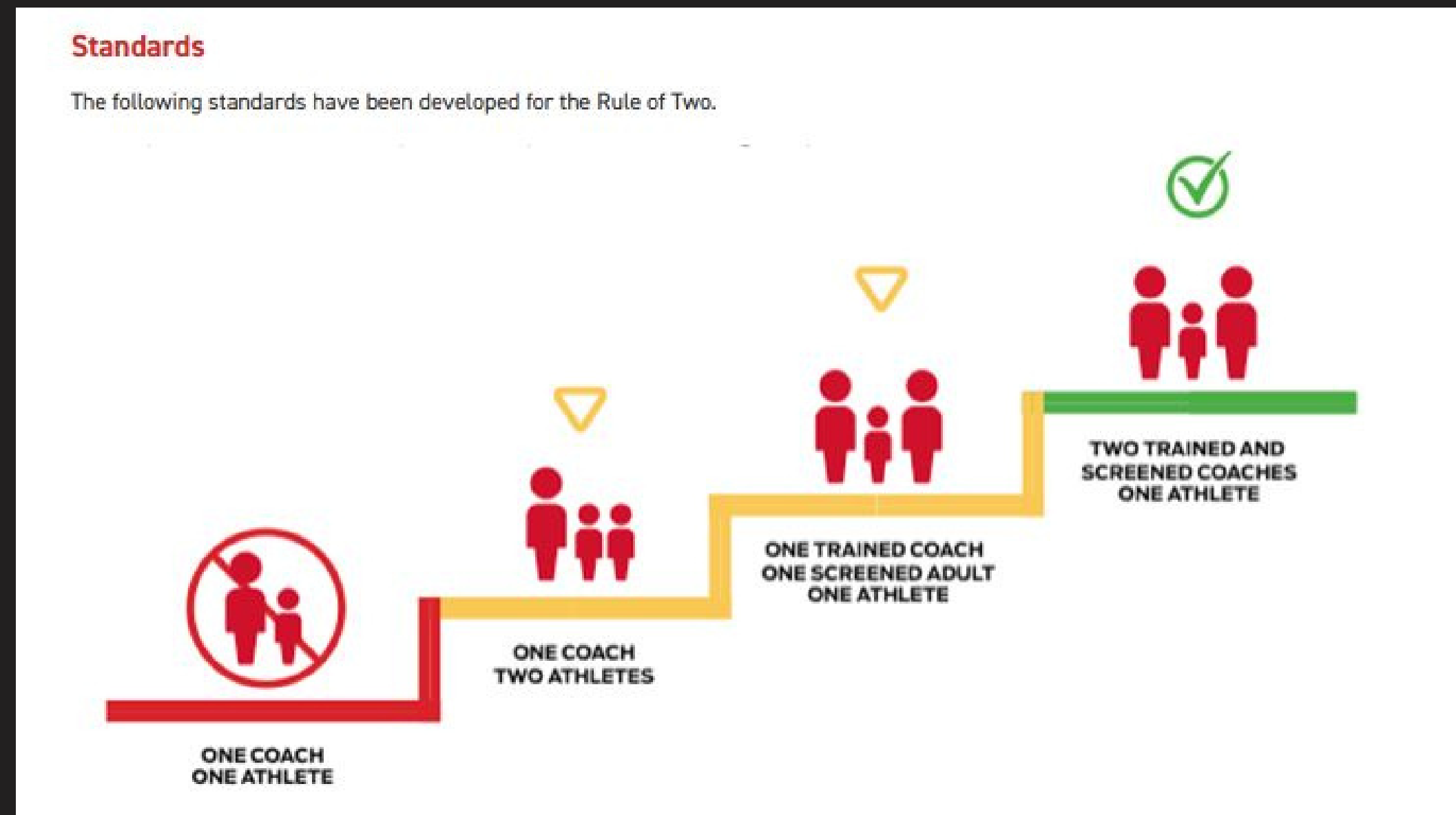

PLAYER SAFETY

Rule of Two

- The Rule of Two serves to protect minor athletes in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring that more than one adult is present
- The Rule of Two states that there will always be two screened and Respect in Sport and NCCP trained or certified coaches with an athlete, especially a minor athlete, when in a potentially vulnerable situation





PLAYER SAFETY

Guidelines for Interacting with Children & Adolescents

- When taking on the responsibilities of the role of the coach you are also taking on a position of trust for the athlete.
- This trust is built on boundaries of professionalism inherent in the coach and athlete relationship.
- The responsibility of maintaining the professional relationship and appropriate boundaries always lies with the adult.



PLAYER SAFETY

Reporting Abuse or Misconduct

- There is a legal and ethical responsibility to act, when a person becomes aware that a child may be or has been abused.
