FIELD START TIMES

Scheduled Start Times

• Field allotments are **55 min** from the start of the scheduled time. For example, if your start time is 5:15 PM, teams should be gathering their things and leaving the field at 6:10 PM. This allows for any needed field set-up changes between bookings and allows the next booking to start on time.



TEAM PERSONNEL

Certifications & Requirements

 Canadian Soccer Association (CSA) is responsible for training coaches from grassroots to national team level.





Full Safe Sport Roster

Any individual who coaches a team (head, assistant, development coaches) that competes against a team outside of their home club, in this case SYSI (i.e. Zone or Community teams who take part in tournaments which involve competition against other SSA MO teams or out-of-province teams). Any individual who coaches in either a Skill Centre or Dedicated player program is required to meet the standards of the full Safe Sport Roster, this includes but is not limited to the Alliance Academy coaches and those coaching the Zone Skill Centre or Dedicated player program sessions.

Modified Safe Sport Roster

Any individual who coaches a team that competes only against teams within their own club (i.e. Zone or Community teams only play other SYSI member Zone or Community teams and do not take part in tournaments which involve competition against other SSA MO teams or out-of-province teams - Mini SISCO would be exempt because it is a tournament solely for SYSI member teams and no other SSA member teams are accepted).




Certifications & Requirements - Optional but Highly Recommended

- <u>Keeping Girls In Sport Training</u> (\$17 ~ Online Learning)
 - Highly encouraged for those coaching coed or female teams.
- Aboriginal Coaching Modules (Free)
 - its content reflects the uniqueness of Indigenous cultures, values, and lifestyles and is rolled out in three modules.
- Commit To Kids (\$12 ~ Online Learning)
 - The Commit to Kids (C2K) for Coaches online training empowers coaches with practical information to help them enhance child and youth safety in sport. It highlights the importance of understanding boundaries, sexual misconduct and reporting inappropriate behaviour.

Codes of Conduct


- The purpose of the Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc.

PLAYER SAFETY Rule of Two

• The Rule of Two serves to protect minor athletes in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring that more than one adult is present

• The Rule of Two states that there will always be two screened and Respect in Sport and NCCP trained or certified coaches with an athlete, especially a minor athlete, when in a potentially

vulnerable situation





PLAYER SAFETY

Guidelines for Interacting with Children & Adolescents

- When taking on the responsibilities of the role of the coach you are also taking on a position of trust for the athlete.
- This trust us built on boundaries of professionalism inherent in the coach and athlete relationship.
- The responsibility of maintaining the professional relationship and appropriate boundaries always lies with the adult.



PLAYER SAFETY

Reporting Abuse or Misconduct

• There is a legal and ethical responsibility to act, when a person becomes aware that a child may be or has been abused.

REFEREES

Referees (U11-U19)

- **No Referee** Games without a referee for whatever reason must get played or both teams forfeit. If a referee does not show up the HOME TEAM will drop the game sheet in the black box, located on the wall (next to the white board) by the Soccer Centre Admissions desk.
- **Field Marshall Program** Each team in U11-U19 must name their Field Marshall and indicate that on the game sheet. The Field Marshall is to stay in the spectator area to help alleviate any spectators from abusing referees.
 - Any team found to be not participating in the Field Marshall program will face the following penalties:

1st Offense: Warning Letter

2nd Offense: \$50

■ Each Additional Offense: \$100

Mentorship – SYSI encourages all teams to fill out the <u>online</u>
 Referee Evaluation Form to help us continue to help develop our officials.



GAME SHEETS

Game Sheet Procedures (U11-U19)

- It is the responsibility of the Home team to collect the game sheet at the Saskatoon Sports Centre admissions or Henk Ruys Soccer Centre admissions prior to the game. If a referee does not show up the HOME TEAM will drop the game sheet in the black box, located on the wall (next to the white board) by the Soccer Centre Admissions desk.
- The game sheet & game score should be provided to the SYSI office by the referee within 48 hours of the game (not always the case so please be patient). **Teams** should take a photo of the game sheet in the event SYSI requests a copy.


Game Sheet Procedures (U11-U19)

- Please review section 14.0 Game Sheets of the SYSI Rules and Regulations
- Team personnel must review the game sheet prior to the start of the game and ensure the game sheet is accurate;
- The following chart is the SYSI game sheet infractions guideline. The chart lists minimum actions that will be imposed; however the SYSI office may impose an alternate penalty.

5 UP - 1 UP RULE

5 up - 1 up (U11 ONLY)

- 5 up 1 up (under-11):
 - If the game gets to a 5-goal differential the trailing team can add a player, and every 3 goals after, you can add an additional player up to a maximum of 3 additional players. If the score goes under the 5-goal differential, they must remove the additional player
