**Re:** **2025 Outdoor Season Format – U17–U19 Girls Alliance B1 & B2 Divisions**

YSI is pleased to share the format and scheduling details for the upcoming 2025 Outdoor Season for the U17–U19 Girls Alliance B1 and B2 divisions.

## **Division Structure & Match Schedule**

Each division (B1 and B2) will consist of two teams. To maximize competition and variety, the following match format will apply:

- **Crossover Matches:**  
Each team will crossover and play both teams from the other division twice (4 games total).
- **In-Division Matches:**  
Each team will play the other team in their own division six times.
- **Total Games:**  
Each team will play a total of 10 league games.

All matches will count toward the official league standings within each division.

## **Medals & Standings**

- YSI will maintain standings for each division throughout the season.
- There will be no playoff or final match — instead, final standings will determine the declared champion and finalist for each division.
- All four teams (two from each division) will be recognized with Gold or Silver medals based on their final placement.
- Medals will be presented by a YSI staff member at each division's final regular season game, which will be held at the Saskatoon Sports Centre as part of a special evening featuring multiple age group finales.

## **Game Nights**

- **B1 Division:** Games will typically be played on **Tuesdays**.
- **B2 Division:** Games will typically be played on **Thursdays**.
- **Crossover Matches:** Teams will play **both Tuesdays and Thursdays** during crossover weeks.

### Permitting Guidelines

Permitting will follow SYSI's standard policies as outlined in the SYSI Rules & Regulations.

- Permitting is allowed for crossover matches, provided the player follows the rules and eligibility guidelines outlined for inter-division play: i.e. *When two divisions are amalgamated into one league, the team from the higher age/division are to adhere to the same permit rules that apply to the lower age/division team. (e.g. if under-17 Alliance B1 is amalgamated with under-17 Alliance B2, then the under-17 Alliance B1 could not permit under-15 Alliance A players when they play against the under-17 Alliance B2 teams and are to adhere to the same permit rules as the under-17 Alliance B2 teams. If it is a game between two under-17 Alliance B1 teams, then under-15 Alliance A players would be eligible permits for such games.)*
- For matches **within the same division**, the permitting rules will follow those applicable to **"Same Division" play** as per the SYSI Permitting Chart.
- All permits must be submitted and approved through the standard process. Teams are responsible for ensuring compliance with eligibility and permitting timelines.
