Re: COVID-19 Confirmed Case Within Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc. (SYSI)

Dear SYSI Participants,

This is to notify you that one confirmed positive case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed within the Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc. (SYSI) League.

**Individuals who were present in the specified soccer facility on the following dates and times are to self-monitor for 14 days:**

- **Tues Nov 17 from 8:00 PM – 9:30 PM – Saskatoon Kinsmen Henk Ruys Soccer Centre**
- **Thurs Nov 19 from 8:00 PM – 9:30 PM – Saskatoon Sports Centre**

The participants of the affected SYSI mini-league have not participated in any soccer activities since the case was brought forward, and the affected mini-leagues have been cancelled for 14 days.

If you did not receive an additional email from SYSI informing you of your mini league being shut down your mini league has not been affected. All those affected within the shut down mini leagues have received an additional email specific to them.

To protect the privacy of the individuals, SYSI will not release any personal information, and ask that you respect the privacy of others. SYSI has worked with Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) and the Business Response Team (BRT) to ensure all necessary measures are in place to protect all participants. This includes the Saskatoon Soccer Centre (SSC) taking extra cleaning precautions due to COVID-19. Also, upon hearing of the exposure, the SSC performed an even further and more extensive cleaning of the soccer centre.

The risk of exposure to anyone not considered a close contact is low. For those who have been in close contact with the case, the SHA will contact you directly and provide direction.
