

Kids in the Park Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register for Kids in the Park?

- Visit saskatoonyouthsoccer.ca
- Click on “Programs” in the blue header at the top of the home page
- Click on the tab “Kids in the Park”
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the link “Registration Now Open! Click Here to Register”
- If you do not have a RAMP account, create one. If you have a RAMP account log in.

How do I register as a Parent/Support Person?

- Click on the following: <https://www.rampregistrations.com/login?v3=0ee3dd2dc5>
- Log into your RAMP account
- Click Executive Registration
- Choose season – 2020 Outdoor Season
- Choose season – 2020 Outdoor Season
- Position – Support Participant
- Choose Family Member – Choose Family member or create a profile the individual who will be participating with the child
- Verify Information
- Click Continue
- Review Waivers
- Use mouse to sign Declaration of Compliance – Covid – 19
- Waivers
- Use mouse to sign Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims and Indemnity
- Use mouse to sign “Please Sign here”
- Click off “I am Age of Majority or am a Parent/Guardian to the Registrant and Agree to the Terms and Conditions Above”
- Click Continue
- Self-identify and click continue. If you do not wish to identify, please ensure N/A is selected and click continue.
- Review registration information
- Click Submit Registration

What should participants bring with them to a session?

- Runners, or soccer/baseball cleats (no metal cleats)
- A closed mouth water bottle (sharing of water bottles is strongly discouraged)
- A ziploc bag with their name on it which contains tissues, masks, closed mouthed water bottles, hand sanitizer and medication (if required). No other personal items will be allowed.
- Participants 9 and younger should have an adult caregiver with them to help with social distancing practices and participation in the activities
- Shin guards (optional)

Are masks required for participants and/or adult caregivers?

- As per provincial health authority guidelines, the use of a mask is highly recommended in all scenarios where the session is not running (attendance/check-in, entering and exiting the field, while observing in the in the spectator designated area, etc.)
- Masks will **not** be provided by the program leaders to adult caregivers

Can participants register for more than one session of Kids in the Park?

- No. To ensure that the highest number of children can take part in the program, participants are limited to one 3- or 4-day session of Kids in the Park.

In case of thunder/lightning or other severe weather what is the protocol?

- In cases of thunder and lightning or heavy rain the program will be cancelled, and participants are to leave the field immediately.
- If a session is cancelled due to weather conditions, it will not be rescheduled
- Emails will be sent out when possible to notify participants of any cancellations.

What happens if a participant must miss a session?

- There are no make up sessions if a participant misses one of their sessions. They can not come to a different session and no missed sessions will be rescheduled.

How do I register my child for Indoor soccer?

- If your child is born between 2012-2016, they can play soccer either through a Community Association or through a Zone Association in the development program. - If your child is born between 2011 – 2002 they can play soccer through a Zone Association.
- Registration typically takes place from beginning of August to early September and dates/locations vary depending on which Community Association or Zone you are registering with.
